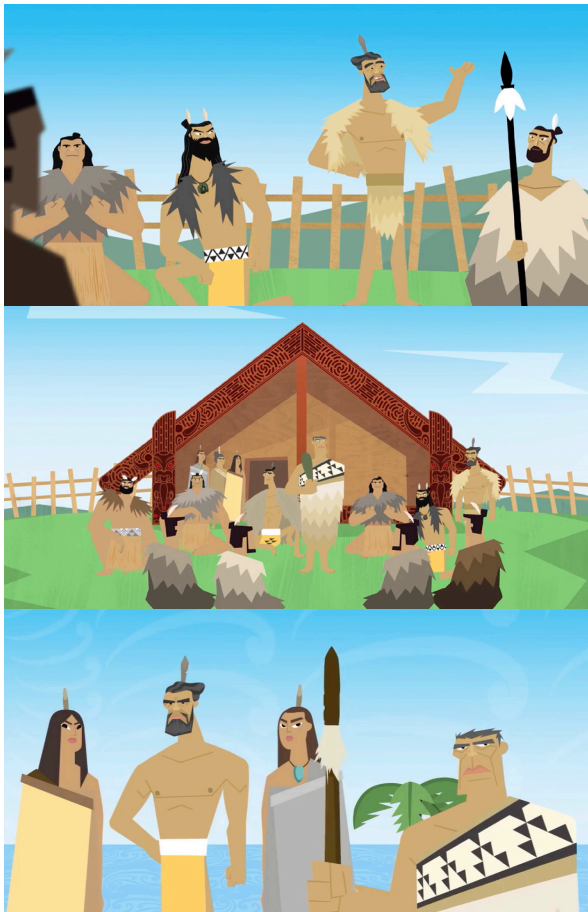


Te Huataki - Speech Bubble One
