

Kaihinu Pā was located on a peninsula and a small island called Mōioio. What is in the water? Add in waka, taniwha, fish, birds and whatever else you think of.






Ngāti Kurī went out fishing and made repeated references to nearby Ngāi Tara fishermen about how good their new fish hooks were.


Decorate the waka and consider what colours you'll use for the water, the fish and sky.


Manawa-i-waho is Pūraho's son-in-law. He escaped and alerted everyone to what had happened to Pūraho. Ngāti Kurī were stunned!


